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About Natstand family documents:

A Natstand family document is intended to provide background information concerning the family of a deceased naturalist. It is hoped that such information will form a framework which will help interpret their surviving correspondence, specimens and records. In some cases it will also give an insight into the influences on their early lives and the family constraints within which they worked and collected. We have found that published family data concerning individuals rarely contain justification for dates and relationships and not infrequently contain errors which are then perpetuated. The emphasis in Natstand family documents will be on providing references to primary sources, whenever possible, which will be backed-up with transcriptions.

Although a Natstand biography page will always carry a link to a family document, in many cases these documents will be presented without any further biographical material. We anticipate that this will occur if the person is particularly well known or is someone we are actively researching or have only a peripheral interest in.

The following conventions are used:

Any persons in the family tree with known natural history associations will be indicated in red type. Any relationships will be to the root naturalist unless otherwise stated.

Dates will be shown in bold type if a reliable reference is presented in the document. In cases where an exact year cannot be given (e.g. it is derived from an age at death), the date will be presented in normal type and preceded with "c" – e.g. c1798. There are some cases where a date is available from a secondary source only (e.g. a published obituary), in these cases it will be presented in italics – e.g. 1823.7.21

Data sources:

Census data have been used, whenever possible, to confirm relationships; they are not considered a reliable source of data concerning age. Contemporary newspaper family notices are considered as reliable sources of relationships and dates; reports and obituaries are treated more cautiously. Parish records generally provide a reliable source of data and digitised images have been used whenever possible. Any difficulties with transcription will be made clear. In some cases only transcripts have been available; errors here are usually confined to spelling. The most important source of this material is the International Genealogical Index compiled by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Utah. National Civil Registration Indexes are considered reliable, as are probate records.

DEATH OF A DISTINGUISHED NATURALIST.

Mr. Henry Walter Bates, F.R.S., the distinguished naturalist and traveller, died the other day from influenza. He was born at Leicester, on the 8th of February, 1825, and early in life threw himself into the study of botany and geology. The Times tells us that entomology in the end was the department of science to which he mainly devoted himself, and in 1848, at the age of 23, his love of science became so strong that he threw up all his prospects in a mercantile life, and with his friend Mr. A. R. Wallace went off to the Amazons to explore its tropical riches. After four years Mr. Wallace returned to England, and, as is well known, proceeded to the Malay Archipelago. Bates stayed on for another seven years, proceeding leisurely from station to station, studying the geography, the people, the fauna and the flora of one of the richest regions on the face of the earth from the naturalist's point of view. He made collections not only in his favourite subject, entomology, but in other departments of natural history, and it was by sending them home to the British Museum and elsewhere that he succeeded in supporting himself. He returned to England in 1859, but it was not until 1863 that he published his work, "The Naturalist in the River Amazons," which has long ago become a scientific classic. was appointed assistant-secretary to the Royal Geographical Society in 1864.

DEATH OF MRS SARAH PEARD.

The death occurred at her daughter's home, 20, Barkston-gardens, Kensington, on Thursday, of Mrs. Sarah Peard, at the age of 70. Until the death of her husband three years ago, Mrs. Peard lived at Fortis Green-avenue, East Finchley, and had been a member of East Finchley Congregational Church for 45 years. Mr J. W. Peard was a deacon at the church for 35 years and at various times held the posts of secretary, treasurer and Sunday School superintendent.

The funeral was on Tuesday, a service at the church being conducted by the minister, the Rev. L. T. Towers, The Internment was at St. Marylebone Cemetery, East Finchley.

Notice is hereby given that the partnership heretofore subsisting between the undersigned HENRY WALTER BATES, JOHN OSCAR BATES, and SAMUEL BATES, of Leicester, Hosiers, and carried on at Leicester under the style or firm of "HENRY BATES," has been dissolved by mutual consent; and that all debts due or owing to or from the said late firm, will be received and paid by the said John Oscar Bates and Samuel Bates, by whom the business will be carried on under the style or firm of "HENRY BATES."

... "Bates was married in 1861. His wife survives him, as also do one daughter, who is married, and three sons, two of whom (the eldest and the youngest) are farmers in New Zealand, while the second son is an electrical engineer."

The deceased gentleman, it may be added, was born in Leicester on Feb. 8th, 1825. The details of the family are correct but the marriage date is not. It seems likely that this was a deliberate attempt to hide the fact that their eldest daughter, now deceased, had been born in Leicester the previous year.

⁴ There is no birth registered of Alice Mason Bates in Leicester, **1862**. The birth of an Alice Mason was, however, registered in the first quarter.

⁵ Grace Helena Peard appears on the passenger list of the *Guildford Castle* in February 1923, sailing to Kenya Colony.

⁶ Charlotte Mary Adams Bates was born after the death of her father. Her vital dates are provided by her death certificate, issued by the Indiana State Board of Health on 1977 September 15 [Local No. 1615 State No. 77-033326]. At her time of her death she was the widow of Mr Slater. Her mother's maiden name is given as Mary Adam(sic) Stephenson and her father as Charles H Bates. Although she died in South Bend Memorial Hospital, St Joseph, Indiana, she was an Australian citizen with an address in Parramatta, New South Wales. She had been born in New Zealand. Her death was notified by her daughter Mrs Thelma S. Stohrer.
