About Natstand family documents:

A Natstand family document is intended to provide background information concerning the family of a deceased naturalist. It is hoped that such information will form a framework which will help interpret their surviving correspondence, specimens and records. In some cases it will also give an insight into the influences on their early lives and the family constraints within which they worked and collected. We have found that published family data concerning individuals rarely contain justification for dates and relationships and not infrequently contain errors which are then perpetuated. The emphasis in Natstand family documents will be on providing references to primary sources, whenever possible, which will be backed-up with transcriptions.

Although a Natstand biography page will always carry a link to a family document, in many cases these documents will be presented without any further biographical material. We anticipate that this will occur if the person is particularly well known or is someone we are actively researching or have only a peripheral interest in.

The following conventions are used:

Any persons in the family tree with known natural history associations will be indicated in red type. Any relationships will be to the root naturalist unless otherwise stated.

Dates are presented Year – Month – Day

e.g. **1820 March 9** or **1820.3.9**
1820 March or **1820.3**

Dates will be shown in bold type if a reliable reference is presented in the document. In cases where an exact year cannot be given (e.g. it is derived from an age at death), the date will be presented in normal type and preceded with "c" – e.g. c1798. There are some cases where a date is available from a secondary source only (e.g. a published obituary), in these cases it will be presented in italics – e.g. *1823.7.21*

Data sources:

Census data have been used, whenever possible, to confirm relationships; they are not considered a reliable source of data concerning age. Contemporary newspaper family notices are considered as reliable sources of relationships and dates; reports and obituaries are treated more cautiously. Parish records generally provide a reliable source of data and digitised images have been used whenever possible. Any difficulties with transcription will be made clear. In some cases only transcripts have been available; errors here are usually confined to spelling. The most important source of this material is the International Genealogical Index compiled by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Utah. National Civil Registration Indexes are considered reliable, as are probate records.

Biographical Notes:

The Rev Thomas Arthur Preston is probably best known to botanists from his active membership of the Botanical Exchange Club, 1863 flora of the area around Marlborough and 1888 *Flowering Plants of Wiltshire*. He was also an enthusiastic general naturalist who maintained an active interest in insects, having first joined the Entomological Society in 1851, and meteorology. He was a master at Malvern College where he was the founder and President/Chairman of the Malvern College Natural History Society. The College society was once lauded as the "parent and model of all similar societies in the public schools of England".

Thomas was a member of an old and established family of Norfolk land owners, some holding official positions within the county. His particular branch of the family was headed by his grandfather Rev George Preston, Rector of Beeston St Lawrence, Norfolk.

Thomas' father, also Rev George Preston, was a second son whose elder brother Isaac had assumed the surname Jermy in 1837. This name change had been part of a complex legal wrangling to satisfy the inheritance conditions of Stanfield Hall which came to Isaac on the death of George senior. The occupation of the Hall by Isaac, at the time the Recorder of Norwich, was disputed in some quarters and resulted in serious local rioting. In 1848 both Isaac and his son Isaac Jermy were murdered at Stanfield Hall in a crime which achieved great national notoriety.

Thomas' father Rev George Preston was for many years associated with Westminster School, where he was Usher from 1818 and Under Master from 1826 until his death in 1841. Thomas Arthur was the third son and seventh child of the 13 children born to George Preston and his wife Emma. All but one of their children survived to adulthood.

Thomas was admitted to Emmanuel College, Cambridge in 1852, elected a foundation scholar in 1853, and graduated with first-class honours in Natural Science in 1857. Elected to the Cambridge Philosophical Society in 1857, he received the thanks of the Society for re-arranging a portion of its insect collection the following year.

He was ordained a Deacon in June 1858 and appointed an Assistant Master at Marlborough College. In 1859 he was awarded an MA by Emmanuel College, Cambridge and ordained a priest by the Bishop of Salisbury.

During his time at Malvern College he was an active member of the Wiltshire Archaeological and Natural History Society, acting as one of their general honorary secretaries. He was also responsible for the establishment of the Society's herbarium. His report to the Society in 1874 indicated that they intended to construct a county herbarium and to that end all identifications had been checked by Mr Britten or Mr Baker of Kew. He was elected FLS 1872.

In 1885 he was appointed Rector of Thurcaston, Leicestershire, a post he retained until his death. At Thurcaston he became active within the Leicester Literary and Philosophical Society, where he became a Council member and maintained an active interest in botany and meteorology. At the time of his death he was engaged in producing a flora of the county.

He did not marry and lived for much of his adult life with two of his unmarried sisters, Mary and Emma.

THE LATE ISAAC JERMY, ESQ.

The unfortunate gentleman who has fallen under the hand of an assassin, - and whose career among us has thus been so suddenly arrested, - was born on the 23d of September, 1789. he was educated at Westminster school, and proceeded from thence to Christ Church, Oxford; where he graduated in due course. On leaving college, he became a student of Lincoln's inn, and was called to the bar as a member of that society. He first married Miss Mary Anne Beevor, daughter of the late Sir Thomas Beevor, Bart., who died in 1823, leaving two children; the late Isaac Jermy Jermy, Esq., who perished with his father, and Mrs. Jephson. - He married, for his second wife, in the year 1832, Miss Fanny Jephson, daughter of Rev. Mr. Jephson, Prebendary of Armagh in Ireland. By that lady, who died in Oct., 1835, he had a daughter Isabella, born a few weeks before the death of her mother.- At the death of his father, Mr Jermy, who had previously borne the family name of Preston, assumed that by which he had, of late years, been known.

The deceased was a magistrate of the county of Norfolk, and one of the chairmen of the quarter-sessions. In 1836, he was appointed Steward, and in 1831, Recorder of Norwich, succeeding in both offices the late Robert Alderson, Esq. He was president of the board of directors of the Norwich Union Fire Insurance Society.

Jermy Jermy, Esq., married Miss Chevalier, of Yarmouth. Her mother, Mrs. Chevalier, is at present, in Boulogne.

THE LATE CAPTAIN THOMAS PRESTON, R.N There has just passed away from our midst, in the person of the above-named gentleman, one of the oldest, and, we have no doubt, one of the best remembered inhabitants that Lowestoft has ever possessed; and none who have at any time been brought into contact with the deceased but have been struck with his personal characteristics and predelections. Captain Preston was also one of the longest residents in the town, having lived here upwards of 50 years. Deceased was the son of the Rev. George Preston, Rector of Beeston St. Lawrence. The deceased filled several public offices, among them being churchwarden from 1841 to 1846, a trustee of the Church and Town Estate, &c. As one connected with nautical matters, many have been the narratives detailed by him connected with personal service, and by those who enjoyed his personal friendship his loss will be much felt. Deceased was in his 91st year.

DESCENDANT OF FAMOUS FAMILY. Miss Caroline Preston Dies At The Age Of 92.

Miss Caroline Preston, who died at 1, Clarendon Road, Norwich, on Sunday at the age of 92, was the third and last surviving daughter of Captain Thomas Preston. R.N., who himself lived to the age of 90. He was born in 1795 at Beeston St. Lawrence (the estate of the Preston family since the year 1640), and after his retirement from the Navy, where he saw active service as young lad, he lived at 1, High Street, Lowestoft, till his death In 1885.

Miss Caroline Preston, who was one the few remaining descendants of the male line of the East Anglian family of Preston, was granddaughter of the Rev. George Preston and his wife, Henrietta, nee Bedingfield. The latter was descendant of Sir Henry Bedingfield, of Oxborough, and his wife Katharine, daughter of Sir Roger Townshend, of Raynham. The Prestons have been largely connected with the history of Norfolk and Suffolk for many centuries. Thomas Preston, the Herald, was in 1633 appointed to the office of Ulster King of Arms, and in 1638 became Lord Deputy of Ireland. 1630, as Herald, he was sent by Charles I. to proclaim the birth of the infant prince (who afterwards became Charles II.) to the people of Ireland.

Isaac Preston, born In 1640, whose father-in-law's town house was the Strangers' Hall at Norwich, was Commissioner for Norfolk in 1695 and was knighted King William III. at Whitehall 1694. Another Isaac Preston, born 1711. was Sub-Steward of Yarmouth, while a third Isaac Preston, who assumed the surname of Jermy and together with his son was murdered at Stanfield Hall in 1848, was Recorder of Norwich and also Sub-Steward of Yarmouth. One Frances Preston was married to William Jermy, of Bayfield, who was High Sheriff of Norfolk In 1746, while earlier Frances Preston was married to Dr. Tanner, Chancellor of Norwich and afterwards Bishop of St. Asaph's, and lies buried with her two daughters in the Bishop's Chapel, Norwich.
